**Entries** Submit entries via Hy-Tek Manager zip file to Kent Vigil at kvigil@cabq.gov by 8:00 PM on Thursday, December 2, 2021. Entries will not be accepted beyond the entry deadline.

Entries for individual events are limited to two entries per gender per school. Entries for relay events are limited to two entries per gender per school. Scratches and entry replacements for individual events shall be made immediately following the swim coaches meeting and no later than 7:45am. Competitors may not be pulled from an event to compete as an entry replacement. Event entry adjustments will not result in reseeding an event; heat and lane assignments will remain as originally seeded and assigned.

Relay team member adjustments made by 7:45am day of meet shall be made directly to the meet management software operator by the head coach. Adjustments after 7:45am day of meet shall be reported by the head coach to the meet referee. Upon approval by the meet referee, adjustments shall be reported by the head coach to both the meet management software operator and timers at assigned lane.

Schedule to declare relay team members including the lead-off swimmer shall be as follows:

200 Yard Medley Relay	Declare relay team members by 7:45am
200 Yard Freestyle Relay	Declare relay team members by start of 100 Yard Girls Butterfly
400 Yard Freestyle Relay	Declare relay team members by start of 200 Yard Girls Freestyle Relay

Divers will perform six dives. Diving scoresheets are due to the diving referee one hour prior to the start of diving competition; failure to submit by the deadline will result in the diver not being eligible to compete in diving competition. Changes to diving scoresheets are permitted up to 30 minutes prior to start of diving competition.

A meet program will be emailed to swim coaches the Friday before swimming competition.

Warm-Up Format for Swimming

7:30am - 8:00am	Circle swimming open in competition pool and warm-up pool
8:00am - 8:20am	Competition pool open for one-way racing starts
8:20am - last event	Warm-up pool open for warming up and cooling down before and after events

There will be a 10 minute break between the 50 yd/m freestyle and the 100 yd/m butterfly.

200 yd/m	girls/boys freestyle
200 yd/m	girls/boys individual medley
50 yd/m	girls/boys freestyle
1m	girls/boys diving*
100 yd/m	girls/boys butterfly
100 yd/m	girls/boys freestyle
500 yd/400 m	girls/boys freestyle
200 yd/m	girls/boys freestyle relay
100 yd/m	girls/boys backstroke
100 yd/m	girls/boys breaststroke
400 yd/m	girls/boys freestyle relay

\*Diving competition is hosted independently from swimming competition; refer to event schedule.

An automatic timing system will be used for timing races. Points will be awarded as follows:

Individual: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relays: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Team championship ties are resolved in the following order:

1. The team with the greatest number of 1st place finishers in individual events shall be declared the team champion.
2. The team with the greatest number of 1st place finishers in relay events shall be declared the team champion.
3. Points earned from a team's highest scoring relay team for each relay event will be compiled; the team with the highest composite score shall be declared the team champion.
4. If a tie still exists, a coin flip among the tied teams shall determine the team champion.

**Awards**

A team trophy will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> place boys team and the 1<sup>st</sup> place girls team. Ribbons will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> place finishers in all events.
